Schedule of Classes

- All entries must be received by the closing date. No late entries accepted.
- All goats must be registered/recorded with the New Zealand Dairy Goat Breeders Association.
- Please provide Herd Book Numbers and tattoo/microchip letters/numbers on the entry form, as well as sire's details.
- All animals entered in special classes 9-13 must be entered in their standard age class.
- Standard age classes for Herd Register and Associate Record does (Classes 1-6) – No Recorded Grades
- All entries must be in the name of the bona fide owner(s). Full name of goat and registration number to be given at time of entry.
- No substitution will be accepted.
- Does must not be milked out before they enter the ring, except for the second half of the udder class.
- No goats to be paraded on chains.
- All goats must be **penned by 9:30am** and be ready for classes starting at **10am**.
- **\$3 per entry** unless stated otherwise.

Note: There will be no Saanen/Sable Show this year. We apologise for the inconvenience.

- Please bring food or drink along for a shared lunch.
- There will be a raffle on the day. Any contributions towards prizes would be much appreciated.

Standard Age Classes for In-milk Does

Class 1 – HR Kiddled Doe in milk, under 3 years.

Class 2 – HR Kiddled Doe in milk, 3 years and under 5 years.

Class 3 – HR Kiddled Doe in milk, 5 years and over.

Champion HR Doe: To be selected from winners of classes 1, 2 and 3.

Reserve Champion HR Doe: The second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 4 – AR Kiddled Doe in milk, under 3 years.

Class 5 – AR Kiddled Doe in milk, 3 years and under 5 years.

Class 6 – AR Kiddled Doe in milk, 5 years and over.

Champion AR Doe: To be selected from winners of classes 4, 5 and 6.

Reserve Champion AR Doe: The second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 7 – Grand Champion Standard Age HR Doe.

Class 8 – Grand Champion Standard Age AR Doe.

Special Classes

Class 9 – Senior Progeny: Two daughters in milk of the same sire but different dams. The names of the sire and dams to be given on the entry form.

Class 10 – Type and Production: Rules as per NZDGBA Regulations.

Class 11 – Breeding Group: 3 does in milk of the same breed, bona fide property of the exhibitor.

Class 12 – HR Best Udder: Open to all does who have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder to be totalled to determine the prize winners. Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for empty udder judging.

Class 13 – AR Best Udder: Open to all does who have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder to be totalled to determine the prize winners. Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for empty udder judging.

Junior Standard Age Classes

Class 14 – HR Maiden Doe or Goatling, over 12 months and under 30 months, that has never borne a kid, including maiden milkers.

Class 15 – HR Doe Kid, 6 months and under 12 months old.

Class 16 – HR Doe Kid, under 6 months old.

Champion HR Junior Doe: To be selected from winners of classes 14, 15 and 16.

Reserve Champion HR Junior Doe: The second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 17 – AR Maiden Doe or Goatling, over 12 months and under 30 months, that has never borne a kid, including maiden milkers.

Class 18 – AR Doe Kid, 6 months and under 12 months old.

Class 19 – AR Doe Kid, under 6 months old.

Champion AR Junior Doe: To be selected from winners of classes 17, 18 and 19.

Reserve Champion AR Junior Doe, The second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 20 – Junior Progeny: Two daughters under 30 months that have not borne a kid, of the same sire but different dams. The names of the sire and dams to be given on the entry form.

Buck Classes

Class 21 – Herd Register Buck Kid, 6 months and under 12 months old.

Class 22 – Herd Register Buck Kid, under 6 months old..

Champion Junior Buck: To be selected from winners of classes 21 and 22.

Reserve Champion Junior Buck: The second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 23 – Herd Register Buck, 12 months and under 2 years.

Class 24 – Herd Register Buck, 2 years and over.

Champion Buck: To be selected from winners of classes 23 and 24.

Reserve Champion Buck: The second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 25 – Grand Champion Standard Age Buck.

Class 26 – Junior Showmanship (no entry fee): 15 years of age and under. To be judged on the exhibitor's ability to lead, place, turn, stop and start their goat. To answer 2 questions. Show preparation and appearance of both exhibitor and goat to be taken into account. Exhibitor's age to be included on entry form.

Class 27 – Junior Herdperson (no entry fee): 15 years and up to 25 years, showing an adult goat. To be judged on presentation and knowledge of the anatomy of the animal, handling and health of the adult goat. The goat does not have to belong to the exhibitor.

Best of Breed: All Champions eligible.
