Rules

- All entries must be received by the closing date, no late entries accepted. (This excludes Junior Handler, Junior Herdsperson, Pet Goat and Fancy Dress classes which may be entered on the day)
- Entries may be received by phone or email (before/on closing date) but entry fees must be paid before the show starts. No payment = Elimination.
- No goats to be paraded on chains.
- All goats must be penned by 9.30am and be ready for classes starting at 10am.
- HR and AR goats must be registered with either Premier Dairy Goats or the New Zealand Dairy Goat Breeders Association.
- Does must not be milked out before they enter the ring, except for the second half of and Udder class.

- Please provide registration numbers and tattoo/microchip letters/numbers on the entry form, as well as sires details

Standard Age Classes For Does

Class 1 – HR Kiddled Doe in milk, under 3 years.

Class 2 – HR Kiddled Doe in milk, 3 years and under 5 years.

Class 3 – HR Kiddled Doe in milk, 5 years and over.

Champion HR Doe, to be selected from winners of classes 1, 2 and 3. Reserve Champion HR Doe, the second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 4 – AR Kiddled Doe in milk, under 3 years.

Class 5 – AR Kiddled Doe in milk, 3 years and under 5 years.

Class 6 – AR Kiddled Doe in milk, 5 years and over.

Champion AR Doe, to be selected from winners of classes 4, 5 and 6. Reserve Champion AR Doe, the second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 7 – Unregistered Doe in milk, 3 years and under.

Class 8 – Unregistered Doe in milk, 3 years and under 5 years.

Class 9 – Unregistered Doe in milk, 5 years and over.

Best Unregistered Doe, to be selected from winners of classes 7, 8 and 9. Reserve Best Unregistered Doe, the second prize winner in the class from which the Best Unregistered was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 10 – Grand Champion Standard Age HR Doe.

Class 11 – Grand Champion Standard Age AR Doe.

Special Classes

Class 12 – Senior Progeny: two daughters in milk of the same sire but different dams. The names of the sire and dams to be given on the entry form.

Class 13 – Type and Production, rules as per NZDGBA & Premier Regulations.

Class 14 – Breeding Group, 3 does in milk same breed, bona fide property of the exhibitor.

Class 15 – HR Best Udder: Open to all does who have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder to be totalled to determine the prize winners. Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for empty udder judging.

Class 16 – AR Best Udder: Open to all does who have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder to be totalled to determine the prize winners. Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for empty udder judging.

Class 17 – Best Unregistered Udder: Open to all does who have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Points awarded for both full and empty udder to be totalled to determine the prize winners. Does must be finally stripped prior to entering the ring for empty udder judging.

Junior Standard Age Classes

Class 18 – HR Maiden Doe or Goatling, over 12 months and under 30 months, that has never borne a kid, including maiden milkers.

Class 19 – HR Doe Kid, 6 months and under 12 months old.

Class 20 – HR Doe Kid, 6 months and under.

**Champion HR Junior Doe, to be selected from winners of classes 18, 19 and 20.
Reserve Champion HR Junior Doe, the second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.**

Class 21 – AR Maiden Doe or Goatling, over 12 months and under 30 months, that has never borne a kid, including maiden milkers.

Class 22 – AR Doe Kid, 6 months and under 12 months old.

Class 23 – AR Doe Kid, 6 months and under.

**Champion AR Junior Doe, to be selected from winners of classes 21, 22 and 23.
Reserve Champion AR Junior Doe, the second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.**

Class 24 – Unregistered Maiden Doe or Goatling, over 12 months and under 30 months, that has never borne a kid, including maiden milkers.

Class 25 – Unregistered Doe Kid, 6 months and under 12 months.

Class 26 – Unregistered Doe Kid, 6 months and under.

Best Unregistered Junior Doe, to be selected from winners of classes 24, 25 and 26. Reserve Best Unregistered Junior Doe, the second prize winner in the class from which the Best Unregistered Junior was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 27 – Junior Progeny: Two daughters under 30 months that have not borne a kid, of same sire but different dams. The names of the sire and dams to be given on the entry form.

Buck Classes

Class 28 – Herd Register Buck Kid, 6 months and under 12 months.

Class 29 – Herd Register Buck Kid, 6 months and under.

Champion Junior Buck, to be selected from winners of classes 28 and 29. Reserve Champion Junior Buck, the second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 30 – Herd Register Buck, 12 months and under 2 years.

Class 31 – Herd Register Buck, 2 years and over.

Champion Buck, to be selected from winners of classes 30 and 31. Reserve Champion Buck, the second prize winner in the class from which the Champion was selected to be paraded with the other prize winners for selection of Reserve.

Class 32 – Grand Champion Standard Age Buck.

Fun Classes

(to be judged after completion of all other classes)

Class 33 – Junior Showmanship (no entry fee): 15 years of age and under. To be judged on exhibitors ability to lead, place, turn, stop and start their goat. To answer 2 questions. Show preparation and appearance of both exhibitor and goat to be taken into account. Exhibitors age to be included on entry form.

Class 34 – Junior Herdperson (no entry fee): 15 years and up to 25 years, showing and adult goat. To be judged on presentation and knowledge of the anatomy of the animal, the handling and health of the adult goat, does not have to belong to the exhibitor.

Class 35 – Pet Goat (no entry fee), open to all goats including wethers, to be judged on goats 'petability'.

Class 36 – Fancy Dress (no entry fee), open to all goats and exhibitors, let your creativity run wild!
